**Intermediate Division** classes are appropriate for students ages 11-18. A placement class is required for enrollment in all Intermediate Division classes. Youth Ballet is recommended for students ages 10-13 with little or no prior ballet experience. Students ages 14 and up who are new to ballet are encouraged to begin their dance training in the School's Open Division.

Classes begin September 6, 2011 and conclude with the Festival Spring Performances June 8-9, 2012. Students in this division also have the opportunity to audition to perform with North Carolina Dance Theatre in *Nutcracker* and other full length ballets such as *Sleeping Beauty*.

Students in the Intermediate Division are eligible to participate in the Student Ensemble performing companies. Members of the Student Ensembles are able to take their training outside the classroom through a variety of performance opportunities including North Carolina Dance Theatre sponsored events and educational outreach presentations in the community. Annual participation dues help cover choreography expenses and the cost of costume construction and maintenance.
